	Welcome & Opening Remarks by the Chairman	At the very outset, the Chairman welcomed all the Hon'ble members of the Academic Council and thanked them for sparing their valuable time for the meeting.
(A)	Confirmation of Minutes of Academic Council	
O.	To confirm the minutes of the previous meeting of the Academic Council held on 13 th September, 2022.	The Chairman informed that the minutes of the meeting of Academic Council held on 13th September, 2022 were circulated and no comments were received from any of the Hon'ble members. The Hon'ble members were pleased to approve and confirm the minutes of the last meeting of the Academic Council.

(B) Action Taken Report

Action taken report on decisions taken in the previous meeting of the Academic Council held on 13th September, 2023.

The Chairman read the following Action Taken Report (ATR) for the information of the Hon'ble members:

- 1. The Hon'ble members are informed that the Academic Session 2022-23 was completed successfully as per the Academic Calendar approved by the Academic Council (except with minor changes regarding certain dates) in its last meeting held on 13th September, 2022.
- 2. The Second Convocation of the University was held on 24th September, 2022 at Jawahar Lal Nehru Stadium New Delhi. The Chief Guest at the Convocation was Hon'hle Bandaru Shri Dattatrava. Governor, Harvana Government, and SRM University Delhi-NCR. Visitor. Sonepat. Hon'ble Mr. Justice Surva Kant, Judge, Supreme Court of India, delivered the Convocation Address. Hon'ble (Dr.) T.R. Paarivendhar, Founder Chancellor, gave Special Address to the audience. At the Convocation, 1489 students of UG/PG and 58 Ph.D. Scholars were given the Degrees. At the Convocation, 12 students received Chancellor Medals. 78 students received Gold Medals, 65 students received Silver Medals and 53 students received Bronze Medals to the eligible candidates as per the Regulations approved by Academic Council.
- 3. Revised Examination Manual as approved by the Academic Council in its last meeting, has been implemented w.e.f. the Academic Session 2022-23.
- 4. In the last meeting of the Academic Council, different policies framed by the University were approved. All the Hon'ble members are informed that the said policies have been put into implementation.
- 5. The University implemented the Scholarship Policy to the tune of Rs.50,000/- every year in tuition fee for B.Sc. Agriculture Science (Hons.) programme and to the tune of Rs.20,000/- every year in tuition fee for B.Sc. Food Technology (Hons.) programme.

- 6. With regard to the proposed new programmes i.e., (i) B.Tech CSE with specialization in Cyber Security (ii) B.Tech CSE with specialization in Big Data Analytics and (iii) B.Sc. (Hons.) Psychology, approved by the Academic Council in its last meeting, could not be introduced as the approval from the Department of Higher Education is still awaited. The University has already submitted its request to the Department of Higher Education for permitting the University to introduced the abovementioned courses.
- 7. The curriculum and syllabi of various courses of different programmes as proposed by the respective Board of Studies and approved by the Academic Council in its last meeting were implemented in the Academic Session 2022-23. The University has further revised the curriculum and syllabi of various courses of different programmes in line with National Education Policy (NEP), 2020 and the same as proposed by respective Board of Studies, are to be approved by the Academic Council.
- 8. The introduction of HR and Data Analytics & Artificial Intelligence, and Short-term programmes of 5-6 weeks / 2-3 months as suggested by the Hon'ble members of the Academic Council in the last meeting is yet to be done. However, the University has started offering MOOCS courses to students. The teachers of the University are being asked to engage in preparation of resource material through MOOCS.
- 9. The suggestion of the Hon'ble members of the Academic Council to reduce the number of credits in each programme as per the AICTE norms has been considered by the University and in various programmes to be offered by the University in the Academic Session 2023-24, the number of credits have been reduced. The suggestion to award dual degree to students is yet to be implemented as the details in this regard are required to be worked out.
