## Report

**Incident:** A physical altercation occurred between two students, Vaibhav Madan and Daksh Grover in Room No. 408(Boy's Hostel)

### **Summary of Incident:**

Vaibhav Madan and Daksh Grover were involved in a verbal argument that escalated into a physical fight. According to witnesses Daksh initiated the physical confrontation, and Vaibhav responded in self-defense. The fight was broken up by their room mates member with the assistance of other fellow students. After initial enquiry with the students and reading their informal what,s app chat, it has been clearly indicate that both are responsible for the incident. They used inappropriate words for their parents in mobile chat and same it was the major reason for physical fight. Both students belong to same department (CSE) with same batch (2023-27).

### **Actions Taken:**

- Both students were called to Warden office.
- Appearance of Parents/guardians of both students were contacted and informed of the incident.
- Warning has been initiated and taken apology letter after getting the request from parents.
- Counseling services offered to both students to stop future conflict.

### **Follow-up:**

- A follow-up call will be held with both students and their parents/guardians to discuss the incident and their behaviour.
- The incident will be documented in hostel grievances file.


I am Vaibhav Madan, a resident of BH SRM, Room No. 408. I am writing this email to bring to your attention that Daksh Grover, a student who resides in Room No. 402, has been verbally abusing my parents and mentally harassing and threatening me for the past 5 months. In the last 2 months, he has even become physically aggressive towards me. Yesterday, at 11:39 PM, Daksh and 7 other individuals were banging on my door. When I opened it, Daksh forcefully entered my room, pushed me, and began physically assaulting me. Despite the efforts of the others present, Daksh continued to attack and verbally abuse me. Notably, Daksh tends to escalate his aggression during my exam periods. This behavior is making me feel unsafe even within my own room. I am aware of other instances where Daksh has threatened violence against fellow students. I sincerely hope that the disciplinary committee will take decisive action against such behavior and ensure that the hostel remains a safe and supportive environment.

Respected Madam/Sir,

In pursuance to the Judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 08.05.2009 in Civil Appeal No. 887/2009, to exercise the powers conferred by clause (g) of sub-section (1) of section 26 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956, the University Grants Commission (UGC) has notified "Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009". The Regulations are available on the UGC website [www.ugc.gov.in](http://www.ugc.gov.in) & [www.antiragging.in](http://www.antiragging.in).

It is once again brought to your kind notice that ragging is a criminal offence and UGC has framed regulations on curbing the menace of ragging in higher educational institutions in order to prohibit, prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging. These regulations are mandatory, and all institutions are required to take necessary steps for its implementation in toto including the monitoring mechanism. Any violation of these regulations will be viewed seriously. If any institution fails to take adequate steps to prevent ragging or does not act in accordance with these Regulations or fails to punish perpetrators of incidents of ragging suitably, Institutions will attract punitive actions as per UGC Regulations for Curbing the Menace of Ragging – 2009.

You are requested to step up anti-ragging mechanism by way of adequate publicity through various mediums: constitution of Anti-Ragging committee and Anti-Ragging squad, setting up of Anti-Ragging Cell, installing CCTV cameras at vital points, Anti-Ragging workshops and seminar, updating all websites with nodal officers' complete details, alarm bells etc. Regular interaction and counseling with the students, identification of trouble-triggers and mention of Anti-Ragging warning in the institution's E-prospectus and E-information booklets/brochures must be ensured. Surprise inspection of hostels, students' accommodations, canteens, rest cum recreational rooms, toilets, bus-stands must be carried out & Anti-Ragging posters must be displayed at all prominent places like Admission Centre, Departments, Library, Canteen, Hostel, Common facilities etc. These posters are available on UGC website [www.ugc.ac.in](http://www.ugc.ac.in). The size of the posters should be at least 8x6 feet. Any other measure which would augur well in preventing/quelling ragging and any uncalled-for behavior/incident must be undertaken.

Students in distress due to ragging related incidents can call the National Anti-Ragging Helpline 1800-180-5522 (24x7 Toll Free) or e-mail the Anti-Ragging Helpline at [helpline@antiragging.in](mailto:helpline@antiragging.in). For any other information regarding ragging, you may please visit the UGC website i.e. [www.ugc.gov.in](http://www.ugc.gov.in) & [www.antiragging.in](http://www.antiragging.in) and contact UGC monitoring agency i.e. Centre for Youth (CYU) on Mobile No. 09818044577 (only in case of emergency). In compliance to the directions of the Anti-Ragging Monitoring Committee constituted by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, HEIs have to implement the following in their institutions:

1. Head of the Universities/Institutions must provide the details of ARC & ARS on the website.
2. Plan for Orientation Programme on Anti Ragging in your Universities/Institutions. The Programme should focus on key aspects of Anti Ragging Regulations and regular feedback of the students after each and every workshop/training/programme should be taken in English, Hindi and Local Language. UGC has made an IEC Kit with suitable content on ragging which is available on UGC website i.e. [www.antiragging.in](http://www.antiragging.in). This kit can be referred for the same.
3. The cultural dadagiri may be controlled by Head of the Universities/Institutions taking police authorities into confidence. In this regard, UGC is also issuing a separate advisory to all District Magistrate/SSP/SP of all districts.

4. The concept of mentor-mentee as given out in the UGC Regulation for Curbing the Menace of Ragging in HEIs - 2009 be followed by students in all institutions to make a comfortable bond amongst Juniors and Seniors.
  5. The Anti Ragging Cell and Anti Ragging Squads of institutions should be empowered by provisioning of legal counsel so that airtight cases against the ragging culprits can be made.
  6. Henceforth for extreme ragging and suicide cases, Principal of the college and Registrar of the University will be called and will be answerable to the National Anti-Ragging Monitoring Committee for the reasons of non-compliance of UGC Regulations for ragging.
  7. All the Councils/Regulatory Bodies must constitute a committee as and when a serious/suicide/death case is reported related to their Council/Regulatory Body to relook into the issue even when case is under police investigation. The Regulatory Bodies/Councils are also advised to appoint a legal person for the matter.
  8. The examination (NEET/IIT JEE) causes high stress over students. There is no stress management mechanism available to cope with this. A team of good counsellors with expertise in yoga, meditation and psychology who can read stressful minds to tackle with such problematic cases need to be available. Therefore, a full time counsellor, Yoga/Meditation teacher/instructor may be appointed.
  9. The Committee has also instructed the Anti Ragging Monitoring Agency to be more vigilant and carry out surprise checks all across the Nation to ensure that the UGC Regulations to curb the menace of ragging are being strictly adhered to by the HEI's, Teaching Staff and the students. Punitive action as mentioned in these regulations will be taken against the defaulters.
- UGC also drives an Anti-Ragging Media Campaign through different modes and has undertaken the following activities to promote the campaign which are available on UGC website [www.ugc.gov.in](http://www.ugc.gov.in)
1. UGC developed 05 TV Commercials of 30 seconds each with different perspective for Parents, Victim and Offenders.
  2. UGC designed and distributed 04 types of posters amongst Universities / Regulatory Authorities / Councils / IITs / NITs / other educational institutions for their prominent display.
  3. UGC consecutively organized 02 Anti-Ragging Competitions for students/faculty/general public for the wider awareness of the menace of ragging.

In compliance of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment in UGC Regulations, you are requested to make it compulsory for each student and every parent to submit an online undertaking every academic year at [www.antiragging.in](http://www.antiragging.in)

You are also requested to implement the revised procedure for students to file an online Anti- Ragging affidavit. The student will receive an e-mail with his/her registration number. The student will forward that e-mail to the Nodal officer in his/her university/college e-mail

Universities/Colleges have to display the email address and contact number of the Nodal Officer of Anti-Ragging Committee of their university/college on their website and campus areas like Admission Centre, Departments, Library, Canteen, Hostel, and Common facilities, etc.

All HEI's are further advised to fill in the complete details of their respective Anti Ragging Committee and Anti Ragging Squad on the website i.e. [www.antiragging.in](http://www.antiragging.in) and also display these lists on the Notice Boards. Universities and Colleges are requested to insert a mandatory column in their university/college's admission form as per the given format:



## Formal Complaint Regarding Harassment and Lack of Response and Teacher's Attempt to Suppress Matter

Respective Authorities,

I hope this email finds you well. I am writing to formally report an incident of harassment and physical abuse that occurred on the 20th of November.

On the mentioned date, a student named Aryan Beniwal confronted me in the corridor, demanding the credentials of the GDSC email account, which I had created using my phone number. Aryan proceeded to take my phone and refused to return it, even when I requested him to do so. I sought help from a faculty member in the NCC office, but Aryan did not comply. Instead, he handed my phone over to his friend, Mukul, who took it into room 408.

In an attempt to retrieve my phone, I followed Mukul into room 408, with Aryan and his friends entering behind me. Aryan physically restrained me by grabbing my hand, and when I managed to free myself, I unintentionally touched Mukul. In response, **Mukul slapped me multiple times**, causing damage to my spectacles. In self-defense, I questioned the unwarranted aggression, pushed Mukul away, and found myself **subjected to physical assault by all four individuals, resulting in multiple injuries.**

I find the behavior exhibited by these individuals to be unacceptable and a violation of the college's code of conduct. I am seeking your assistance and intervention in addressing this matter promptly. I am willing to provide any additional information or statements required for a thorough investigation into this incident.

On the same day i.e. 20th November 2023 and 21st November 2023, **I approached Concerned Authority to report the incident** of harassment and physical abuse. Regrettably, instead of registering my formal complaint, **The Concerned Authority chose not to take any action** and, to my shock, registered a counter complaint against me. The counter complaint was filed by Ms. Vanshika, the head of GDSC.

What is more distressing is that it seems some **teachers are attempting to suppress this matter**. Their actions are causing me significant emotional distress, as I now find myself not only facing a lack of support but also being falsely accused. I believe this counter complaint is part of an effort to silence the real issue at hand.

The inaction on The Concerned Authority's part and the apparent attempt to suppress this matter by some teachers have added to my **distress**, and I am now experiencing severe emotional turmoil, which has led to **feelings of depression and suicidal thoughts.**

I appreciate your prompt attention to this matter and look forward to a resolution that ensures the safety and well-being of all students within the college community.

In pursuance to the Judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 08.05.2009 in Civil Appeal No. 887/2009, to exercise the powers conferred by clause (g) of sub-section (1) of section 26 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956, the UGC notified "Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009". The Regulations are available on the UGC website [www.ugc.gov.in](http://www.ugc.gov.in) & [www.antiragging.in](http://www.antiragging.in).

It is once again brought to your kind notice that ragging is a criminal offence and UGC has framed regulations on curbing the menace of ragging in higher educational institutions in order to prohibit, prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging. These regulations are mandatory, and all institutions are required to take necessary steps for its implementation in Toto including the monitoring mechanism. Any violation of these regulations will be viewed seriously. If any institution fails to take adequate steps to prevent ragging or does not act in accordance with these Regulations or fails to punish perpetrators of incidents of ragging suitably, it will attract punitive action against itself by the UGC.

You are requested to step up anti-ragging mechanism by way of adequate publicity through various mediums: constitution of Anti-Ragging committee and Anti-Ragging squad, setting up of Anti-Ragging Cell, installing CCTV cameras at vital points, Anti-Ragging workshops and seminar, updating all websites with nodal officers' complete details, alarm bells etc. Regular interaction and counseling with the students, identification of trouble-triggers and mention of Anti-Ragging warning in the institution's E-prospectus and E-information booklets/brochures must be ensured. Surprise inspection of hostels, students' accommodation, canteens, rest cum recreational rooms, toilets, bus-stands must be carried out & Anti-Ragging posters must be displayed at all prominent places like Admission Centre, Departments, Library, Canteen, Hostel, Common facilities etc. These posters are available on UGC website [www.ugc.ac.in](http://www.ugc.ac.in). The size of the posters should be 8x6 feet. Any other measure which would augur well in preventing/quelling ragging and any uncalled-for behavior/incident must be undertaken.

The Committee has also instructed the Anti Ragging Monitoring Agency to be more vigilant and carry out surprise checks all across the Nation to ensure that the UGC Regulations to curb the menace of ragging are being strictly adhered to by the HEI's, Teaching Staff and the students. Punitive action as mentioned in these regulations will be taken against the defaulters.

UGC also drives an Anti-Ragging Media Campaign through different modes and has undertaken the following activities to promote the campaign which are available on UGC website [www.ugc.gov.in](http://www.ugc.gov.in)

1. UGC developed 05 TV Commercials of 30 seconds each with different perspective for Parents, Victim and Offenders.
2. UGC designed and distributed 04 types of posters amongst Universities / Regulatory Authorities / Councils / IITs / NITs / other educational institutions for their prominent display.
3. UGC consecutively organized 02 Anti-Ragging Competitions for students/faculty/general public for the wider awareness of the menace of ragging.

In compliance of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment in UGC Regulations, you are requested to make it compulsory for each student and every parent to submit an online undertaking every academic year at [www.antiragging.in](http://www.antiragging.in)

You are also requested to implement the revised procedure for students to file an online Anti-Ragging affidavit. The student will receive an e-mail with his/her registration number. The student will forward that e-mail to the Nodal officer in his/her university/college e-mail.

Universities/Colleges have to display the email address and contact number of the Nodal Officer of Anti-Ragging Committee of their university/college on their website and campus areas like Admission Centre, Departments, Library, Canteen, Hostel, and Common facilities, etc.

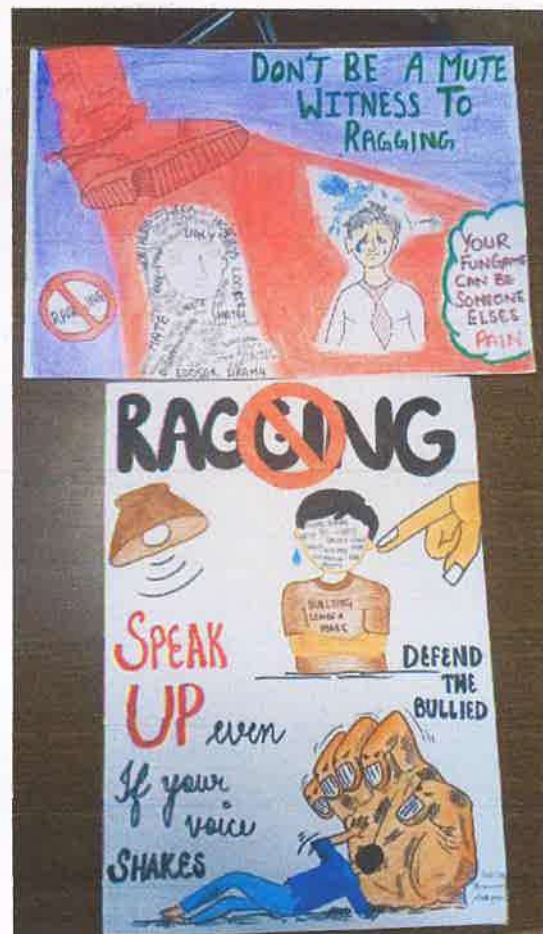

Dear Colleagues,

Greetings! You have already received emails from the Office of Registrar about the Constitution of the Anti-Ragging Committee and the Anti-Ragging Squad with the approval of the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor. While the members of the Committee and Squad are tasked with the specific responsibility to ensure that there is no case of anti-ragging which happens in and around the campus, each one of us have an important role to play here. There is a greater need to sensitise our students about the menace of ragging.

As the Chair of the Anti-Ragging Committee seeking your full support to prevent any case of ragging on campus. Your role as faculty members and staff members of this University is very crucial in this regard.

UGC had notified 3rd Amendment in UGC Regulations on 29th June, 2016 to expand the definition of ragging by including the following: 3. (i) Any act of physical or mental abuse (including bullying and exclusion) targeted at another student (**fresher or otherwise**) on the ground of colour, race, religion, caste, ethnicity, gender (including transgender), sexual orientation, appearance, nationality, regional origins, linguistic identity, place of birth, place of residence or economic background."

As you would observe, the above definition is very broad and hence it is important for all of us to be sensitive towards the diversity of our students and inculcate a value system in them, so that the issue of ragging is nipped in the bud itself.

Dear Colleagues,

Greetings! You have already received emails from the Office of Registrar about the Constitution of the Anti-Ragging Committee and the Anti-Ragging Squad with the approval of the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor. While the members of the Committee and Squad are tasked with the specific responsibility to ensure that there is no case of anti-ragging which happens in and around the campus, each one of us have an important role to play here. There is a greater need to sensitise our students about the menace of ragging.

As the Chair of the Anti-Ragging Committee seeking your full support to prevent any case of ragging on campus. Your role as faculty members and staff members of this University is very crucial in this regard.

UGC had notified 3rd Amendment in UGC Regulations on 29th June, 2016 to expand the definition of ragging by including the following: 3. (i) Any act of physical or mental abuse (including bullying and exclusion) targeted at another student (**fresher or otherwise**) on the ground of colour, race, religion, caste, ethnicity, gender (including transgender), sexual orientation, appearance, nationality, regional origins, linguistic identity, place of birth, place of residence or economic background."

As you would observe, the above definition is very broad and hence it is important for all of us to be sensitive towards the diversity of our students and inculcate a value system in them, so that the issue of ragging is nipped in the bud itself.

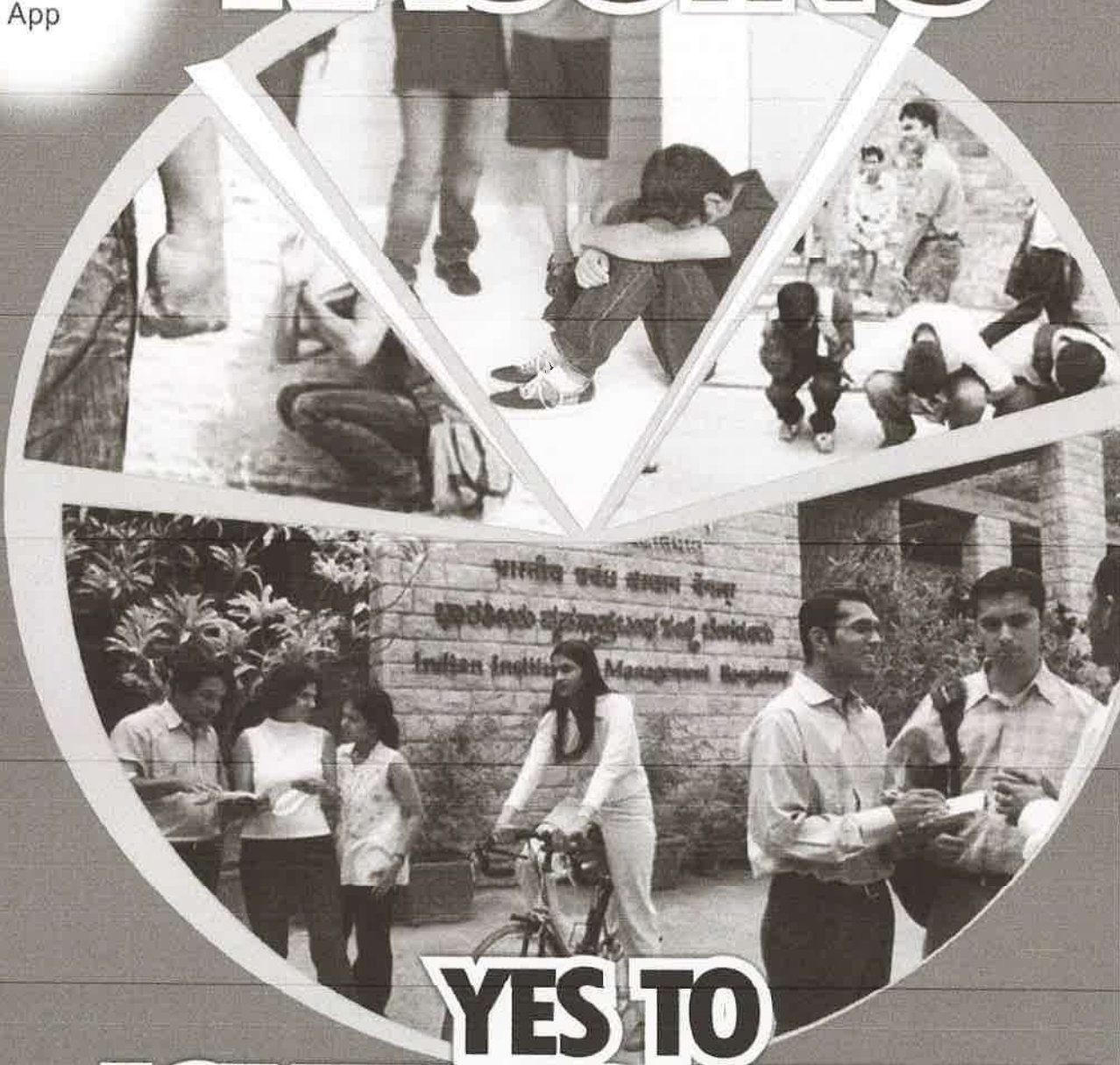

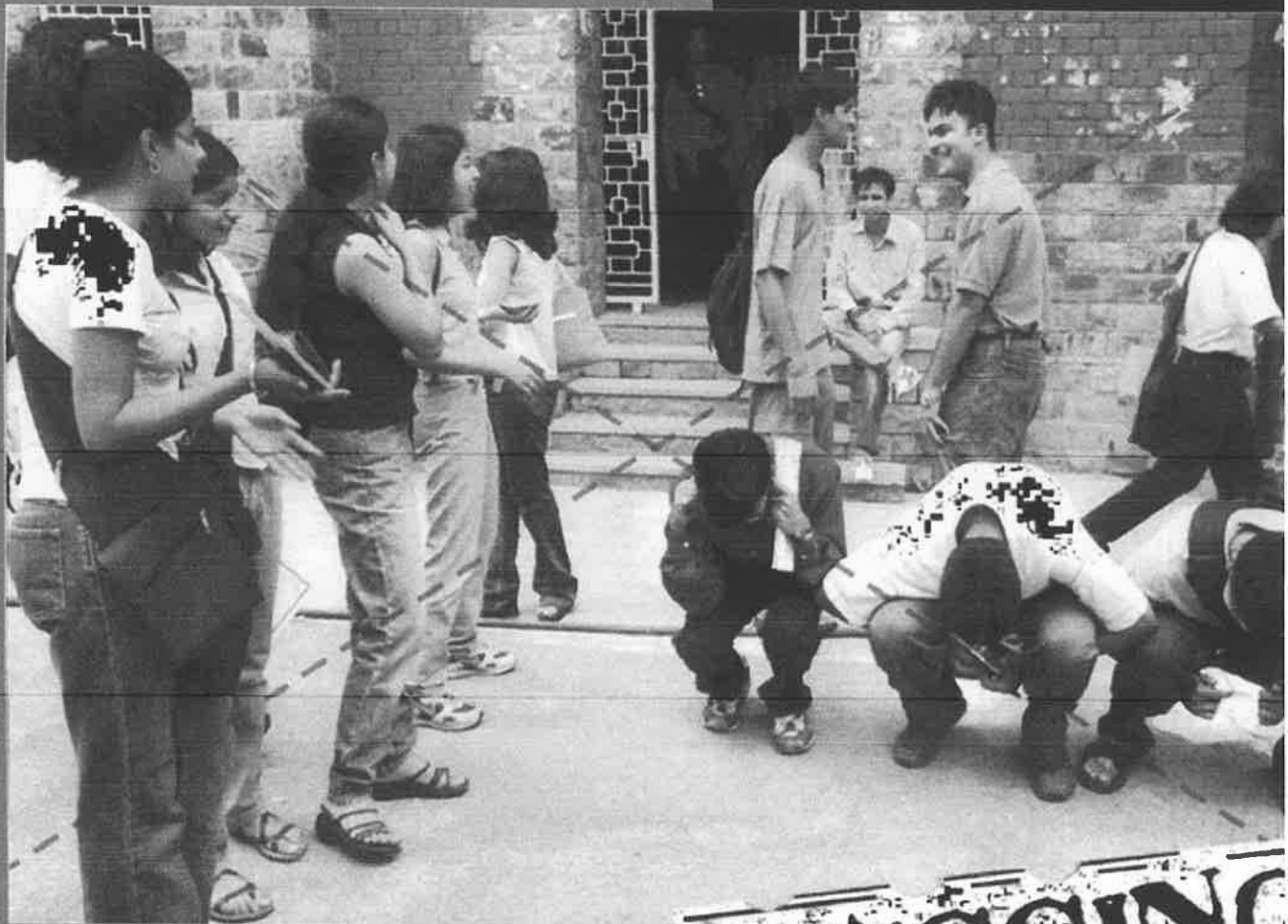
