Independence Day	Every year on August 15th, India observes Independence Day as a public holiday to mark the nation's independence from the United Kingdom on that day in 1947, when the provisions of the Indian Independence Act took effect, transferring legislative authority to the Indian Constituent Assembly.
Republic Day	India observes Republic Day as a national holiday to commemorate the 26th of January 1950, when the Indian Constitution went into effect. This took the place of the Government of India Act 1935 as the country's governing law, transforming India into a republic distinct from the British Raj. The Indian Constituent Assembly ratified the constitution on November 26, 1949, and it went into effect on January 26, 1950. The date of January 26 was chosen as Republic Day since it was on that day in 1930 that the Indian National Congress proclaimed the Declaration of Indian Independence.
Holi	One of the most celebrated holidays and an old Hindu traditional festival is Holi. It honors Radha Krishna's enduring and heavenly love. The day also denotes the triumph of good over evil, as it recalls the victory of Lord Vishnu as Narasimha Narayana over Hiranyakashipu. Due to the Indian diaspora, it began and is primarily observed in the Indian subcontinent, but it has also expanded to other parts of Asia and the Western world.
Diwali	Diwali, Dewali, Divali, or Deepavali, sometimes referred to as the Festival of Lights, is an Indian religious holiday that is associated to Jain Diwali, Bandi Chhor Divas, Tihar, Swanti, Sohrai, and Bandna. One of the most significant holidays in Hinduism is observed during the Hindu lunisolar months of Ashvin (according to amanta tradition) and Kartika. It typically lasts five days (or six in some parts of India) (between mid-October and mid-November). It is a post-harvest festival honouring the abundance after the subcontinent's monsoon season.
Eid	The earlier of the two official Islamic festivals, Eid al-Fitr, also known as the Festival of Sweets, is observed (the other being Eid al-Adha). Muslims worldwide observe the holy holiday because it signifies the conclusion of the month-long Ramadan fast, which

Christmas Day is a recognized state holiday in many nations, is observed religiously by the majority of Christians and culturally by many non-Christians, and is a central component in the season of giving built around it.
Matrabhasha Diwas	Every year on February 21, people worldwide observe International Mother Language Day to raise awareness of linguistic and cultural diversity and encourage multilingualism. Ganesh Chaturthi	Ganesh Chaturthi, also called Vinayak Chaturthi or Ganeshotsav (Gaetsava), is a Hindu holiday honoring the birth of Ganesha. Ganesha's clay idols are placed both publicly on elaborate pandals and privately in houses to honour the event (temporary stages). Chanting of Vedic hymns and Hindu scriptures, such as prayers and vrata, are among the customs observed (fasting).
Onam	In the Indian state of Kerala, there is an annual harvest festival called Onam. The Malayalam calendar month of Chingam, which in the Gregorian calendar overlaps with August and September, has it falling on the 22nd nakshatra Thiruvonam. A well-known myth claims that the event is held to welcome King Mahabali, whose spirit is claimed to travel to Kerala during Onam.






DANCE FLASH BOMB: 21TH AUGUST 2023
