



Guidelines for the Grievance Redressal Committee

Scope:

- a. The Grievance Committee shall consider only individual grievances raised individually by the concerned aggrieved employee.
- b. The Grievance Committee shall not consider any grievance of general applicability or of collective nature of raised collectively by more than one employee.

Procedure, Periodicity and Attendance at Meetings:

- a. The Grievance Committee will meet at least once in three month. However, if necessary, it may meet more frequently at the instance of the Nodal Officer or at the request of the other members to discuss the various issues received.
- b. At least three members of the Grievance Committee shall be present in a meeting.
- c. If a member of the Grievance Committee is connected with the grievance of the aggrieved individual, the concerned member of the Grievance Committee shall not participate in the deliberations regarding that individual's case.
- d. If the aggrieved person happens to be a member of the Grievance Committee, then he shall not participate in the deliberations as a member of the Committee when his/her representation is being considered.

Terms of Reference:

- a. The Grievance Committee shall consider all grievances submitted in writing by an individual employee regarding employment, working conditions and any other alleged injustice done to an employee while discharging his duties at the Institute.
- b. The Grievance Committee shall have access to all files confidential or otherwise relevant to the individual's grievance.

- c. The Committee shall study the petition and after looking into the relevant documents discuss with those concerned and submit its recommendations and report to the Registrar as expeditiously as possible, but in any case within three months of the date of petition.
- d. In case of any difficulties, the Grievance Committee shall have discussion with the Registrar/Vice-Chancellor before a decision is taken.
- e. The Registrar/Vice-Chancellor, as far as possible, shall be guided by the advice of the Grievance Committee unless the recommendations of the Committee violate basic rules and norms of the Institute.
- f. The final settlement of any grievance shall be made within a reasonable period (normally not exceeding one month) after the recommendations are submitted to the Registrar/Vice-Chancellor by the Grievance Committee.

Procedure for Redressal of Grievances:

- a. The aggrieved member shall submit his petition to the Registrar with a copy to the Nodal Officer/Chairman of Grievance Committee. If needed the Nodal Officer shall inform the matter to the Head of concerned department.
- b. On receipt of a petition the Grievance Committee will endeavour to send its recommendation to the Registrar within one month if possible, but in any case not beyond three months, for further action.
- c. Where the petition comes through the Departmental Head he shall either redress the grievance or forward it to the Divisional Head within two weeks. The Divisional Head, after processing it shall send his findings and recommendations to the Grievance Committee within two weeks. The Grievance Committee shall look into the petition, discuss with the concerned person, refer to the relevant documents and send its recommendations to the Registrar for further action.

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
