In line with the directives of the University Grants Commission (UGC) and the institution's commitment to ensuring a safe, inclusive, and student-friendly learning environment, Anti-Ragging Week was observed at SRM University, Delhi-NCR Sonapat Haryana from **August 12, 2025 to August 22, 2025** which included the orientation and induction of first year students to the University.

Anti-Ragging Day – August 12, 2025

Anti-Ragging Day celebration at SRM University, Delhi-NCR, Sonapat, was a vital initiative aimed at creating a safe, inclusive, and respectful campus environment. The event reaffirmed the University's strong commitment to eradicating all forms of ragging, bullying, or harassment among students. Anti-Ragging Day was observed on 12th August 2025, followed by Anti-Ragging Week from 12th to 18th August 2025, in compliance with the directives of the University Grants Commission (UGC).

Inaugural Programme – Anti-Ragging Day (12th August 2025)

The week-long observance began with an Inauguration and Awareness Programme on Anti-Ragging Day, held on Tuesday, 12th August 2025. The programme was graced by **Prof. (Dr.) Pramjit Singh Jaswal, Vice Chancellor, SRM University**, Sonapat, as the Chief Guest.

The event commenced with a warm welcome address by Prof. (Dr.) Vijay Kumar Singh, Dean (Law) & Chairman, Anti-Ragging Committee, who highlighted the significance of Anti-Ragging Week and elaborated on the latest UGC guidelines for higher education institutions. He also referred to recent court orders on ragging, thereby sensitizing students and faculty about the legal framework and judicial approach to the issue. Prof. Singh further encouraged students to participate in the UGC & C4Y National Contest 2025, which includes:

The **Hon'ble Vice Chancellor** addressed the gathering, sharing his personal experiences and reflections on ragging. He strongly emphasized the importance of eradicating ragging from all

educational institutions and reaffirmed SRM University's status as a **ragging-free campus**. He highlighted the psychological and physical harms caused by ragging and outlined the strict legal consequences associated with such acts. He urged students to remain vigilant, proactive, and supportive in ensuring a safe and inclusive environment for all.



As part of the programme, Dr. Upendra Singh, Associate Professor & Member Secretary, Anti-Ragging Committee, briefed students about the activities scheduled for Anti-Ragging Week and encouraged maximum participation. *Dr. Neelu Chaudhary*, the NSS Coordinator, invited students to actively take part in the Oath Ceremony and Tree Plantation Drive under the Nasha Mukta Abhiyan scheduled for 13th August 2025, which also falls within the anti-ragging week celebrations.

 Programs should provide comprehensive education about what bullying is, how to recognize it, and its impact on individuals and communities.
- 02. CLEAR POLICIES AND PROCEDURES**
 Develop and implement a clear anti bullying policy that defines the actions, reporting procedures, and consequences associated with bullying.
- 03. TRAINING FOR STAFF AND TEACHERS**
 Provide regular training for teachers and staff on how to identify bullying, appropriate interventions, and how to support students involved as victims or perpetrators.
- 04. PROMOTION OF POSITIVE SCHOOL CLIMATE**
 Create a positive school environment that encourages respect, inclusion, and kindness among all students. A supportive and positive environment can significantly reduce incidents of bullying.

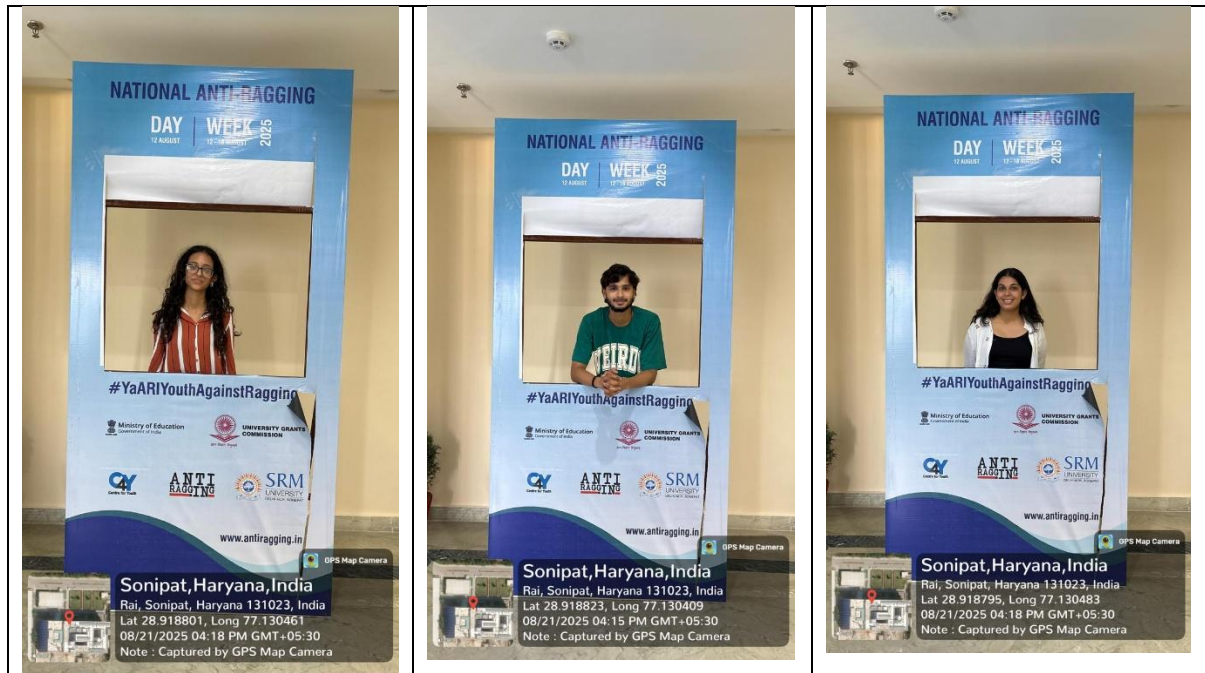

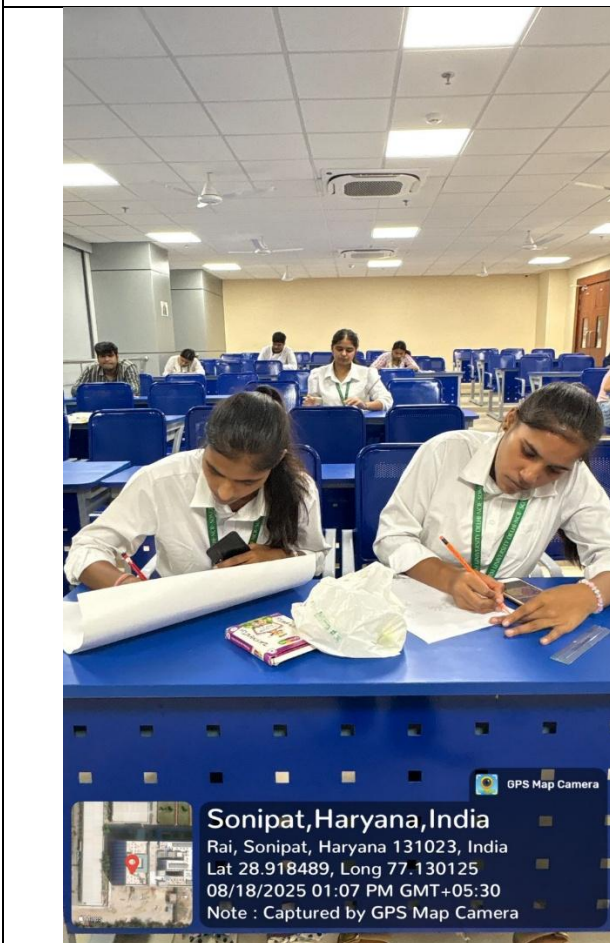

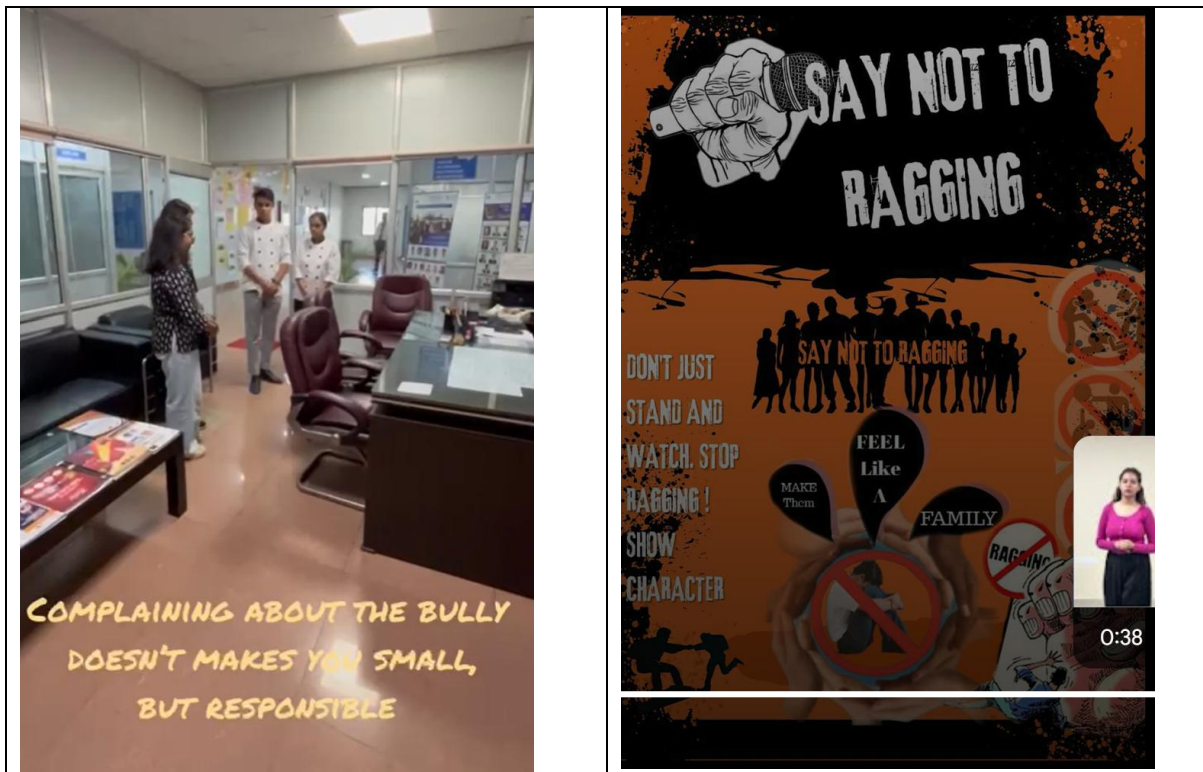
