The terms of reference for the Anti-Ragging Committee:-

1. Ensure strict implementation of the UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions and other applicable statutory provisions.
2. Create awareness among students regarding anti-ragging measures through orientation programmes, notices, and other preventive initiatives.
3. Monitor the campus, hostels, and other University premises to prevent incidents of ragging.
4. Examine complaints relating to ragging and recommend appropriate action in accordance with the applicable rules and regulations.
5. Review the effectiveness of anti-ragging measures and submit periodic reports and recommendations to the Competent Authority.
6. The Committee shall meet at least once in every Academic Year to review matters relating to the prevention of ragging and the effective implementation of the anti-ragging measures and its mandate. The Committee may also convene additional meetings as and when required or on an ad hoc basis, depending upon the nature and urgency of the issues brought before it.
7. The quorum for the meetings of the Committee shall be two-thirds of the total members, including the Chairperson. In the absence of the Chairperson, the senior-most member present shall preside over the meeting.
