1.1 About Us – Overview

SRM University Delhi-NCR Haryana (SRMUH) carries forward the legacy of SRM Group of Institutions. SRM's initiative towards the cause of quality education began in 1969 with the establishment of a primary school and today after five decades of its existence it has 22 institutions and 4 Universities. SRMUH was established as a State Private University under the Haryana Private Universities Act, 2006 (as amended by Haryana Act No. 8 of 2013), in furtherance of the objective of the SRM group to reach out to a greater number of stakeholders in Northern India. The University aims to emerge as a leading world-class educational institution that disseminates knowledge upholding the highest standards of instruction in all fields of study. Along with academic excellence and skills, the University curriculum is developed in a manner to impart experiential learning & life-skills, and, ensures that learners are exposed to various activities, which instill in them social sensitivity, compassion, patriotism, moral, and ethical integrity. Accordingly, when the learners graduate, they emerge as citizens who are best suited to serve society and also undertake various leadership duties.

It is a multidisciplinary University with all the privileges and pride to exist and expand as a world-class educational institution. SRMUH is developed in sylvan surroundings amidst lush green fields. The University campus is spread over 47.38 acres of land and has a well-designed architectural layout. Students from over twenty-five different States and UTs of India and also various parts of the world study here. At present, the University is offering sixty-eight programmes. The campus is well-equipped with a state-of-the-art infrastructure, laboratories, sports, transport, healthcare, and other educational & recreational facilities. Hostel facility is provided inside the University campus for students (Boys and Girls) as well as staff.

The hostels with the state-of-the-art infrastructure provide an ambience of home away from home. The hostels are spacious, centrally air-conditioned, and well-furnished with attached bathrooms. The hostels are supported by spacious mess where staff and students dine together and it also has recreational amenities like a gymnasium, indoor sports, and cafés. Painted in white and yellow colours, twenty-two buses, which are fully air-conditioned, ply on the designated routes covering NCR area and adjoining cities covering parts of Sonapat, Delhi, Ghaziabad, Panipat, Karnal, Baraut, Baghpath, Gohana and Rohtak.

SRMUH is recognized under section 2 (f) of the UGC Act, 1956. It has the approval of all Regulatory Bodies, such as, Bar Council of India (BCI), National Council for Hotel Management and Catering Technology (NCHMCT). SRMH CAT

These programs include engineering, management, law, and commerce. The University also accepts recognised entrance examination like CLAT, JEE, CAT, etc. scores for admissions.

SCHOLARSHIPS

To encourage and support meritorious candidates, SRM University, Sonapat has implemented a very distinctive scholarship programme called the SRMH Scholar Search Programme'. Under this Programme, an applicant may qualify for a scholarship for up to 100% of the University Tuition Fee. Eligibility criteria continuation of Scholarship - (Haryana Domicile & Chancellor Scholarship)

1. For 100% & 75 % scholarship – Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) shall be 9.00 and above.
2. For 50% scholarship – Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) shall be 8.00 and above.
3. For 25% scholarship – Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) shall be 7.00 and above.
4. For 10% scholarship – Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) shall be 6.00 and above.

**CENTRE FOR DRUG DESIGN
DISCOVERY & DEVELOPMENT**

Centre for Drug Design Discovery and Development (C4D) is established at SRMUH to initiate drug discovery projects focusing on neglected infectious diseases with national and international collaborations. The centre has the infrastructural facilities for drug discovery, developing diagnostic kits and tackling antimicrobial resistance. At present the centre has many projects funded by various Government funding agencies, such as, DBT, ICMR, DSIR, SERB, DST, etc.

The objectives of the centre are to

- Discover new drugs against neglected and emerging infectious diseases such as Tuberculosis, dengue chikungunya, kala azar, malaria, meningitis, diarrheal diseases and other neglected diseases caused by parasites, virus and gram-negative pathogens. Synergy studies with existing FDA approved drugs and formulation development as well as using nanotechnology to overcome toxicity issues.
- Exploring natural products as a source of antibiotics, and plant/ herbal extracts as a source of treatment.
- Discovering new chemical entities using focused chemical library and fragment based drug discovery.

- Re-purposing of drugs for the improvement of treatment against Visceral Leishmaniasis with the aim of averting the emergence of PKDL.
- Surveillance of antimicrobial resistance to monitor the emergence of multi-drug resistance in pathogens causing serious infections.



6.6 Health facilities

SRMUH is dedicated to promoting the health and well-being of neighbouring communities through the PR Institute of Medical Sciences & Research (PRIMSR) Hospital and higher educational opportunities, in line with SDG-3. PRIMSR, a hospital situated on the SRMUH campus in Rajiv Gandhi Education City, has been established to provide quality healthcare, especially to the underserved and rural farming communities. The hospital offers free treatment

in various specializations such as eye check-up camps, dental check-ups, and General Medicine check-ups.

PRIMSR also organizes numerous health sensitization and advocacy camps focusing on conditions like Tuberculosis and Heart Diseases. Additionally, the University supports a generic pharmacy under the Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Prayojana, offering quality medicines at subsidized prices. The hospital is equipped with biochemistry, serology, microbiology, and X-ray labs to further support medical services.

Medical facilities are comprehensive, offering 24*7 access to medical aid and ambulance services through PRIMSR Hospital, located on campus. The hospital includes outpatient departments in various specializations like ENT, Ophthalmologist, Dental, General medicine, General surgery, Orthopaedics, Women and Child Health, along with Xray, beds and biochemistry lab facilities. The Pradhan Mantri Jan Aushadhi Kendra provides affordable generic medicines.

6.8 Anti-Ragging Cell

National Ragging Prevention Programme

SRMUH Ensures "Ragging-Free" Campus with the fullest co-operation of Students and Staff.

What Constitutes Ragging

Ragging constitutes one or more of any of the following acts:

- Any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student
- Indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student
- Asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, torment, or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student
- Any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts, or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher
- Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students
- Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students

- Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm, or any other danger to health or person
- Any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, posts, or public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student
- Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or show off power, authority, or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student

Actions against students indulging and abetting in Ragging

- The punishment to be meted out to the persons indulged in ragging has to be exemplary and justifiably harsh to act as a deterrent against the recurrence of such incidents. The students who are indulged in ragging should be debarred from being admitted to any technical institution in India.
- In Every single incident of ragging a First Information Report (FIR) must be filed without exception by the institutional authorities with the local police authorities.
- Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offense as established by the Anti-Ragging Committee of the institution, the possible punishments for those found guilty of ragging at the institution level shall be any one or any combination of the following.
 - Cancellation of admission.
 - Suspension from attending classes.
 - Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits.
 - Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process.
 - Withholding results.
 - Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
 - Suspension/expulsion from the hostel.
 - Rustication from the institution for period ranging from 1 to 4 semesters.
 - Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution.
 - Fine of INR 25,000.
 - Collective punishment: when the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent to ensure community pressure on the potential raggers.

Admission procedure and facilities provided to International Students

International Admission Procedure

The procedure for admission is given below:

Step 1

- International students should apply on a separate form prescribed for Foreign nationals/NRI/Sponsored candidates. Available on admissions.srmuniversity.ac.in.
- The candidate preferably has to apply/register on the prescribed form ONLINE admissions.srmuniversity.ac.in only. He/she may also apply Offline. For this the candidate may contact the Admission office admissions.ir@srmuniversity.ac.in.
- The application form registration fee of 3000 INR / 50 US \$ is required to be paid through a crossed Bank Demand Draft drawn in favor of SRMERI payable again New Delhi. The candidate can also transfer the required amount of fee in the account of SRMUH from any bank or credit card. This should be done well in time, so that the student is able to obtain the VISA and No Objection Certificate before the due date of admission.

Step 2

Get the Provisional Allotment Letter (PAL) from the Directorate of International Affairs, in order to obtain the VISA (on payment of nonrefundable advance amount of 500 USD or the Indian equivalent).

Step 3

Submit the Provisional Allotment Letter (PAL) to the Indian Embassy of the respective country for obtaining the student/researcher VISA.




